Danica Patrick on the Indianapolis 500:

“This has been a great month for the Motorola team. We have not had a whole lot of time on the track, but the time that we have been on track has been great. I am happy about starting in the second row, but this is a long race and I have to be patient and consistent throughout the entire race. My crew has worked very hard to get me a strong car and I feel confident that we will have a strong finish.”

Danica Patrick Facts

- Patrick won her first IndyCar Series race in 2008 at the Indy Japan 300
- This is Patrick’s fourth start at the Indianapolis 500.
- Patrick’s best start was fourth in 2005.
- In 2005, Patrick finished fourth which was her best finish at the Indianapolis 500.
- She finished seventh in the 2007 IndyCar Series standings.
- Patrick had four top-five and 11 top-10 finishes in her first year of driving for Andretti Green Racing, including finishes of third at Texas and Nashville, and a fifth-place finish at Mid-Ohio.
- In 2005, she won the Bombardier Learjet Rookie of the Year award after finishing 12th in the final standings, recording two top fives and seven top 10s, including a fourth in the Indianapolis 500®.
- Patrick is one of only 18 drivers in IndyCar Series history to earn three pole positions, those coming at Kansas Speedway, Kentucky Speedway and Chicagoland Speedway in her rookie season.
