Motorola Driver Danica Patrick 2008 Iowa Corn Indy 250 at Iowa Speedway

Danica Patrick on the Iowa Corn Indy 250:

"I am looking forward to going back to the Iowa Speedway. There was such a great fan turnout last year – the fans were excited and that in turn makes the drivers excited. The next three races are going to be challenging. I am getting more confident on the short ovals, and the Motorola team had a great test this week, so we are going to use that momentum going into this weekend in Iowa."

Danica Patrick Facts

- Patrick won her first IndyCar Series race in 2008 at the Indy Japan 300.
- This is Patrick's second start at Iowa Speedway.
- She finished seventh in the 2007 IndyCar Series standings.
- Patrick had four top-five and 11 top-10 finishes in her first year of driving for Andretti Green Racing, including finishes of third at Texas and Nashville, and a fifth-place finish at Mid-Ohio.
- In 2005, she won the Bombardier Learjet Rookie of the Year award after finishing 12th in the final standings, recording two top fives and seven top 10s, including a fourth in the Indianapolis 500®.
- Patrick is one of only 18 drivers in IndyCar Series history to earn three pole positions, those coming at Kansas Speedway, Kentucky Speedway and Chicagoland Speedway in her rookie season.

Kyle Moyer, Race Strategist, on the Iowa Corn Indy 250:

"Even though we won the race last year in Iowa, it was one of the worst tracks for Andretti Green. We had a great test this week in Richmond, the test went flawless, the track was hot – and with those conditions we are more prepared this year for the next few short oval races. We have a much better car this year than we did last year. Danica is getting more confident on these types of tracks, so I believe that we are in a great position going into Iowa this weekend."
